





Fire Weather Outlook




Cold Front

- **Wind shift to northwesterly 10-20 mph; some higher gusts behind the front**
- **Enters the western Panhandles (Dalhart, Boise City) 10 PM – 11 PM**
- **Central Panhandles (Amarillo, Guymon, Borger) 1 AM-3 AM**
- **Eastern Panhandles (Beaver, Canadian, Wellington) 5 AM – 7 AM**


Low Temperature (F) Ending Tue May 31 2011 10AM CDT

Summary



- **This Evening...**

- Critical to extremely critical fire weather conditions west of the dryline through 10 PM
- Winds: South to Southwest 25-35 mph with gusts to 50 mph
- Min RH: 5-15% west of dryline
- 20-30% chance of strong/severe storms east of the dryline
- Cold front brings abrupt wind shift tonight and into early Tuesday morning
