

<b>Falling temperatures Locally heavy snow</b>	Eastern upper and far Northwest Lower	Wednesday- Wednesday night	Snow-covered roads





# Forecast Weather Map Wednesday Morning






# Forecast Snowfall




## Snowfall Wednesday






# Forecast Weather Map Thursday Morning






# Lake Effect Snow Thursday and Friday
