# Climate Outlook Highlights




- For February 2013, near normal temperatures and above normal precipitation are favored for North Dakota.
- Below normal temperatures and above normal precipitation are favored for most of North Dakota through April 2013.
  - For February – April 2013, near normal precipitation is favored for western North Dakota.
- Drought is expected to improve in parts of southern and eastern North Dakota through April 2013.



### Precipitation




## February – April 2013



### Temperature




### Precipitation
