Key Points

- **An elevated Fire Danger is expected again on Thursday especially in the southwest part of the state.**


Main Impacts



- **Large limbs could be broken from trees.**
- **Power lines may be knocked down, leading to possible power outages.**
- **Objects not secured will be blown about by the wind.**
- **Explosive fire growth is likely for any fires.**




