Ice Storm

Low pressure moved from Mississippi on the afternoon of the 7th, to Ohio by the evening of the 8th. This low spread a mixture of freezing rain, sleet and snow across parts of southeast lower Michigan including the Flint, Saginaw and Thumb regions. The heaviest of the freezing rain fell in the Saginaw area where it caused power outages to 200 customers and some flight delays at Tri Cities International Airport.
