


# January 2013 Weather in Review



Jan 1, 2013 - Jan 31, 2013




Observed daily maximum and minimum temperatures are connected by dark blue bars.

Jan 1, 2013 - Jan 31, 2013





Jan 1, 2013 - Jan 31, 2013**





Jan 1, 2013 - Jan 31, 2013**





Jan 1, 2013 - Jan 31, 2013**





Jan 1, 2013 - Jan 31, 2013**





 Red line connects record high temperatures. Light blue line connects record low temperatures.


**Temperature Summary for SAN ANTONIO STINSON AP

## January 2013 Rainfall...

The monthly rainfall in January 2013 was the first time since September 2012 that rain for a month has been above normal. Most of the rain in January came on January 8th and 9th. Rainfall amounts from January 8th to 9th were as follows: Austin Mabry 2.49 inches; Austin Bergstrom 2.25 inches; Burnet 1.87 inches; Del Rio 1.26 inches; Hondo 1.36 inches; New Braunfels 1.87 inches; San Antonio 2.53 inches; and San Antonio Stinson 2.65 inches. The rains on January 8th and 9th, 2013 were the most widespread rains since September 28th and 29th, 2012.

HIGHEST LOW MINIMUM OF 69 ON JANUARY 28TH BROKE THE PREVIOUS RECORD OF 66 ON JANUARY 28, 1956.

HIGH OF 85 ON JANUARY 29TH BROKE THE PERVIOUS RECORD OF 82 ON JANUARY 29, 2006.

## JANUARY 2013 RECORDS SET AT DEL RIO

### JANUARY DAILY RECORDS...

HIGHEST LOW MINIMUM OF 62 ON JANUARY 27TH BROKE THE PREVIOUS RECORD OF 60 ON JANUARY 27, 2001.

HIGHEST LOW MINIMUM OF 66 ON JANUARY 28TH BROKE THE PREVIOUS RECORD OF 62 ON JANUARY 28, 1975.

HIGH OF 87 ON JANUARY 29TH BROKE THE REVIOUS RECORD OF 82 SET ON JANUARY 29, 1917.

A DAILY RECORD RAINFALL OF 0.89 INCHES WAS OBSERVED AT DEL RIO ON JANUARY 9TH, 2013, BREAKING THE OLD RECORD OF 0.63 INCHES IN 1931.

HIGHEST LOW MINIMUM OF 69 ON JANUARY 28TH BROKE THE PREVIOUS DAILY RECORD OF 66 ON JANUARY 28, 1975, AND THE JANUARY MONTHLY RECORD HIGH MINIMUM OF 68 ON JANUARY 1, 1916 AND JANUARY 18, 1990.



### JANUARY MONTHLY RECORDS...


HIGHEST LOW MINIMUM OF 69 ON JANUARY 28TH BROKE THE PREVIOUS DAILY RECORD OF 66 ON JANUARY 28, 1975, AND THE JANUARY MONTHLY RECORD HIGH MINIMUM OF 68 ON JANUARY 1, 1916 AND JANUARY 18, 1990.

A few of the heavier 24 hour rainfall events ending at 7 AM in January 2013 are shown by the 24 hour rainfall maps below.


### 24Hr Rainfall Ending 7AM JAN 1, 2013




### 24Hr Rainfall Ending 7AM Jan 4, 2013




# 24Hr Rainfall Ending 7AM Jan 5, 2013




# 24Hr Rainfall Ending 7AM Jan 6, 2013




# 24Hr Rainfall Ending 7AM Jan 8, 2013




