

April 2011 Weather in Review

April of 2011 was one of the warmer and drier Aprils of record, continuing a trend of much drier than usual weather, that began in October 2010. The dry conditions have contributed to warmer conditions. April 2011 was the warmest April at Austin Mabry since 1856; the warmest at Del Rio since 1906; the 3rd warmest at San Antonio since 1885; and the 6th warmest April at Austin Bergstrom. April 2011 tied with April of 1955 and 1998 for the 2nd driest April at Del Rio in 105 years since 1906; the 2nd driest at San Antonio in 140 years since 1871; the 3rd driest at Austin Bergstrom in 68 years since October 1942; and the 6th driest April at Austin Mabry in 155 years since 1856.

The outlook for May 2011 from the Climate Prediction Center calls for the average monthly temperature to have a 40 percent chances of being warmer than normal; a 33.3 percent chance of being near normal; and a 26.7 percent chance of cooler than usual conditions. The outlook for rain shows around a 40 percent chances of being drier than normal; a 33.3 percent chance of being near normal; and a 26.7 percent chance of being wetter than usual. May is usually one of the wettest months of the year, along with June, September, and October.
