


# April 2012 Weather in Review



Apr 1, 2012 - Apr 30, 2012




Observed daily maximum and minimum temperatures are connected by dark blue bars.

Apr 1, 2012 - Apr 30, 2012




Observed daily maximum and minimum temperatures are connected by dark blue bars.

### Temperature Summary for Del Rio Area Apr 1, 2012 - Apr 30, 2012





**April of 2012 was one of the warmer and drier Aprils of record, following a period of more rain than usual from December 2011 to March 2012. The coolest lows for April at most locations came on April 21st and 22nd, in wake of a strong cold front that moved across South Central Texas on Friday, April 20th. Much warmer than usual temperatures came from the 24th to the 30th. The warmest day of the month was on the 26th, when several locations over the west part of South Central Texas reached the 100 degree mark. The summer like days at the end of the month and more intense late April sunlight, enhanced the dryness that began in early April.**

**April 2012 was the 6th warmest April for Austin Mabry since 1854. For rainfall April 2012 was the 6th driest April at Austin Mabry since 1856. At Austin Bergstrom April 2012 was the 12th warmest April and the 3rd driest April since 1943. April 2012 was a tie with 1955 for the 7th warmest April at Del Rio since 1906. At San Antonio April 2012 tied with April 1955 for the 8th warmest April since 1885. For rainfall April 2012 was the 3rd driest April at San Antonio since 1871.**
