

## **June 2011 Summary and Driest October to June Periods**

**June 2011 brought many sunny, hot and dry days, as the ground remained very dry, along with the intense June sun. Brief rains came in early and late June, similar to the weather patterns in May.**

**The warmest Junes at Austin, Del Rio and San Antonio are listed below, with the year and average temperature for each June shown. June 2011 was the 2nd warmest June at Austin Mabry, the 3rd warmest June at Del Rio, and the 4th warmest June at Austin Bergstrom and San Antonio.**



**In June 2011 Austin Mabry tied with June of 2009 for the most consecutive 100 degree days in the month of June, 10, from June 12 to 21, 2011. Austin Bergstrom had 9 consecutive days of 100 degrees in June 2011, from June 13th to the 21st, one day less than the June record of 10 days in June 2009. Del Rio in June 2011 had 10 consecutive 100 degree days from June 12 to 21. The record for Del Rio in June is 18 days in June of 1953. San Antonio had 6 consecutive 100 degree days in June 2011 from June 14 to 19. The record number of consecutive 100 degree days for June at San Antonio was 8 days in June of 1980.**

**Conditions since October 2010 have been one of the drier October to June and January to June periods at Austin, Del Rio and San Antonio. June 2011 rainfall was less than normal. the rains from the week of June 19 to June 25 brought enough rain to keep June 2011 out of the top 10 driest Junes of record. The table below shows the June 2011 rainfall amounts.**

**Austin Mabry had 10.97 inches of rain from October 2010 to June 2011. This tied with October 1970 to June of 1971 for the 3rd driest October to June at Austin Mabry since 1856.**
