


Minimum Temperature Forecast - March 18, 2015

Minimum Temperature Forecast - December 12, 2014






Maximum Temperature Forecast - December 12, 2014





Water Vapor Imagery 730 pm MST Dec 7, 2014




A fairly persistent upper level ridge of high pressure (yellow lines accompanied by the big blue “H”) will keep hold of the western US this week.

A few weather disturbances will move northeast (denoted by the cyan arrows) over the top of the ridge axis. However, little more than breezy winds & some mid & high clouds will impact southeast Wyoming & western Nebraska panhandle as these weather disturbances will not carry much moisture to produce precipitation.

What Can Water Vapor Imagery Tell Us?

Water Vapor Imagery from GOES highlights areas in the atmosphere where *moist air* is located (areas of white/grey, blue, green & other bright colors), as well as areas of *dry air* (broader areas of black, brown, & deep orange). Water Vapor Imagery is very useful for identifying atmospheric circulations.
