


Saturday's Forecast




Heavy Snow Possible

Duration


Snow Increases Friday

Current Winter Storm Warnings and Advisories




Winter Storm Warnings: La Plata and Archuleta Counties

Snow Totals through 5 PM Monday




Snow Continues through Monday

Some Tips

- Start from the Edge
- Shave Snow down to 2-3 Inches
- Metal Tools Conduct Electricity
- Remove Large Icicles
- Wear Protective Headgear/Goggles
- Keep Gutters/Drains Clear



Travel Hazards



Mountain Travel:

- **Chains and Adequate Snow Tires**
- **Expect Delays and Possible Road Closures**
- **Poor Visibility from Heavy Snow, Fog, and Blowing Snow**
- **Have a Well Equipped Vehicle** — Batteries, Sand/Cat litter, Windshield Scraper, Blankets, Waterproof Matches, High Calories Snacks, Empty Can to Melt Snow
