...PRELIMINARY MAY 4 2010 STORM INFORMATION...

THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE IN GREEN BAY PERFORMED A DAMAGE SURVEY OF AREAS AFFECTED IN NORTHERN WINNEBAGO COUNTY BY THE MAY 4 2010 STORM.

BASED ON DAMAGE PATTERNS...EYEWITNESS ACCOUNTS...AND RADAR DATA...THERE APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN TWO TORNADOES IN THE COUNTY.

NOTE: THIS INFORMATION IS PRELIMINARY AND MAY BE ADJUSTED AS ADDITIONAL INFORMATION BECOMES AVAILABLE.

...TORNADO 1...

THIS TORNADO SNAPPED NUMEROUS PINE TREES IN A WOODED AREA AND THREW A GAZEBO INTO THE SIDE OF A HOUSE. THE TORNADO ALSO DESTROYED A BARN.

...TORNADO 2...

LOCATION: 3.4 MILES SOUTHWEST OF LARSEN TO NEAR LARSEN
MOVEMENT: EAST-NORTHEAST
PATH LENGTH: 3.3 MILES
PATH WIDTH: 150 YARDS
RATING: EF0
WINDS: ESTIMATED 80 MPH

THIS TORNADO DAMAGED SEVERAL STRUCTURES. IT DESTROYED A SHED...SWIRLING 2 BY 4`S IN THE AIR. THE 2 BY 4`S STRUCK A HOUSE...CAUSING DAMAGE TO THE ROOF. IT THREW A TRAILER ABOUT 200 YARDS INTO A FIELD AND RIPPED SIDING OFF A GARAGE AND KNOCKED OVER A SMALL CAMPER TRAILER.

IN ADDITION TO THE TORNADO DAMAGE...THUNDERSTORM WIND DAMAGE WAS ALSO NOTED NEAR NORTHERN LAKE POYGAN NEAR BOOM BAY. WINDS HERE WERE ESTIMATED AT 80 TO 90 MPH.
