






WEATHER BRIEFING

Hazardous Weather

Timing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Onset: Tonight; See First Two Slides• Ending: Wind Direction Dependent; See First Two Slides
Timing of most intense	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Weather – 7 PM to 3 AM; Morning Commute Affected
Snow Amounts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Accumulations – 1-3 Tonight; See First Two Slides• Accumulations – 1-3 Thursday; See First Two Slides
Icing / Mixed precipitation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All Snow; Fairly High Water Content Tonight• Snow Becoming More Powdery Thursday
Wind	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tonight: Southwest 5 to 10 MPH.• Thursday: Northwest 10 to 20 MPH.
Secondary Hazard	<ul style="list-style-type: none">•

WEATHER BRIEFING

Impacts

Travel Conditions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Snow/Slippery/Poor Visibilities in Heavier Snow Bands
Commutes Affected	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Thursday Morning/Afternoon; See first two slides
Temps	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Low to Mid 20s Tonight• Holding Steady Low to Mid 20s Thursday
Wind Chill	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Teens
Visibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mostly 1-3 Miles; Lake Effect Fluctuations (Occasional 1/2 Mile or less)

Summary

- Another Event Tonight/Thursday Similar to Monday Night/Tuesday
- Prolonged Lake Effect Thursday Night Through Saturday, Heavy at Times with Significant Accumulations Possible
