


Rainfall Past 7 Days


Forecast for Today

- Min RH's in the 40s



Forecast for Friday




- Drying out, and warming up
- Highs in the 60s
- RH's in the 30s

Forecast for Saturday




- Mainly dry
- Mild with highs in the 60s
- RH's in the 30s

Forecast for Sunday




- Slight chance of rain north
- Warm with highs around 70
- RH's in the 30s

Forecast for Monday




- Warm and slightly breezy
- Dry conditions continue
- Highs in the 70s
- RH's in the 30s

Forecast for Tuesday




- Continued warm with highs in the 70s
- Winds a little less breezy
- RH's in the 30s

Forecast for Wednesday




- Chance of rain increases
- Highs in the 70s once again
- RH's increase

Valid: 8PM WED to 8PM MON

8-14 Day Temperature Outlook



Valid: May 2 – May 8

Summary

- One more cool day today with a chance of rain mixed with snow
- Warming and drier trend begins on Friday and continues into the first portion of next week
- Highs warming into the 70s
- RH's generally in the 30s after today, some upper 20s late in the weekend/early next week
- Next best chance of rain after today will be Wed-Thu
