


Severe Weather Details

Today through Wednesday



<p>What</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Periods of thunderstorms This afternoon through Wednesday evening • Greatest Potential: Damaging Winds and Large Hail • Limited Potential: Tornadoes • Localized Flooding Also Possible: If thunderstorms occur in the same areas
<p>When</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Today: Early Afternoon through around midnight • Tuesday: Late morning through midnight • Wednesday: Late morning through mid evening
<p>Where</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Today: All of Lower Michigan, with areas near and west of US-131 having the greatest risk • Tuesday : All of Lower Michigan Tuesday • Wednesday: Southern half of Lower Michigan, may miss us to the south
<p>Forecast Confidence</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Storms may develop sooner Today and Tuesday • Strongest storms may miss us all together to the south on Wednesday





60 mph and Stronger



Hazards Summary Review

Today through Wednesday



- **Damaging Winds and Large Hail this afternoon through Wednesday afternoon**
 - This afternoon the storms are possible across the area but the greatest risk is expected to be near or west of US-131
 - Tuesday the storms are possible across the area in the afternoon and evening
 - Wednesday the storms should mostly be near and south of I-96
- **Isolated Tornado Possible Today into Wednesday afternoon**
 - The front will be stalled near I-96, so storms crossing the front may develop a tornado briefly
- **Locally Heavy Rainfall Possible – over most of the area**


