




# Winter Weather Impact Summary

## Heavy Snow and Strong Winds Expected 4 pm Monday – Tuesday Evening

### Expected Impacts

**Dangerous Travel –  
Highway Closures Lasting Several Hours**

**Isolated Power Outages**

**Whiteout Conditions At Times**

**Event Cancellations and School Closures**  
**Flight Delays**  
**Possibly Wednesday As Well**

### Expected Impacts

**Hazardous Travel – Very Slow Speeds**  
**Numerous Accidents**

**Isolated Power Outages**

**Quick Changes in Visibility**

### Possible Impacts

**Event Cancellations and School Closures**  
**Flight Delays**

**Immediate – Life Saving Action**

**Extremely Life Threatening**  
Everything Will be Shut Down Possibly for Days or Weeks

**Be Prepared – Major Actions**

**Expect Dangerous Conditions**  
Expect Major Disruption of Normal Activities

**Be Aware – Minor Actions**

**Caution – Especially When Travelling**  
Plan to Be Inconvenienced

**Little to No Action**

**Little to No Impact on Daily Life**  
Plan on Minor Inconvenience


**Better than 50/50 Chance**

# Snowfall and Wind Details

Monday, November 17 - Tuesday, November 18



**Lake-effect snow, heavy at times,  
Expected Monday afternoon  
Through much of Tuesday**

**Winds gusting over 25 MPH  
Causing considerable blowing snow**

**Snow and strong winds combined  
May cause whiteout conditions**

***Temperatures falling to 20 or colder  
Enhancing impacts Monday evening***

***Wind chills near 0 Tuesday morning***
