







Harrison County Severe Wind Events 1/1950 - 7/2009









10/30/1967 – A super cell thunderstorm spawned a tornado that initially touched down on the northeast side of Gulfport. The tornado was responsible for 4 deaths and an additional 17 injuries. It also caused an approximate \$25M in damage and was rated an F3.

4/13/1980 – A severe thunderstorm produced a strong tornado that initially touched down near Vancleave. The tornado traveled northeast causing approximately \$25M in damage along its approximately 16 mile path. Though no one was killed by the tornado, 25 people did suffer injuries that ranged from minor to serious.

11/24/2004 – A tornado traveled east to west on path along Dedeaux Road between Highway 49 and Three Rivers Road in the Orange Grove community. Most of the damage was rated F1 intensity by a NWS ground survey, however there were areas of F2 damage. A large church under-construction was destroyed, and three homes and five businesses received major damage. Twenty other homes suffered minor damage. Damage was estimated at \$3M.
