


5/14/2008 – Hail ranging in size from golfballs to baseballs was reported near Erwinville.





3/2/1995 – A severe thunderstorm produced strong winds that damaged the structure of a building by moving it 3 to 5 feet off of its foundation. Strong winds also blew a third of the roof off of a home, caused minor roof damage to a couple of buildings, and overturned a rental truck. Total damage was estimated around \$50K.



2/29/1972 – A supercell storm produced a tornado that touched down near Erwinville. The tornado moved northeast for approximately 1 mile before lifting. Though its track was short, the tornado caused substantial damage, injured 3 people, and was rated an F3.

6/8/1989 – A cluster of severe storms moved across south central and southeast Louisiana. One of the stronger tornadoes (an F2) began near Grosse Tette in Iberville Parish and moved northeastward into West Baton Rouge Parish. Most of the damage from this tornado was done in the Grosse Tette area. The same storm spawned a second tornado that touched down near Lobdell in West Baton Rouge Parish. The tornado continued to move northeastward for about 9 miles, moving into East Baton Rouge Parish and causing \$2.5M in damage. It was rated an F2.
