A tornado touched down about 2 miles north of the Loranger and traveled on an intermittent path approximately 1.5 miles long. 10 to 15 large trees were toppled or uprooted, one barn destroyed, an out building damaged and a house damaged.

Isolated severe thunderstorms developed ahead of a cold front that moved through southeast Louisiana during the evening hours.
