


- **Last of the steady precip exiting the Bluegrass and Lake Cumberland**

After Midnight




Slight Chance of Freezing Drizzle across the area, tapering off from west to east by morning.


Round Two: A “Reverse Storm” for the second half of the weekend.


- Return flow of warm, moist air from the south will flow in over the cold ground and snowpack in place after Friday's storm.
- Precipitation will start as snow in the north and freezing rain and sleet to the south late Saturday night. In a reverse pattern from Friday, this will give way to rain during the day Sunday.

Round #2 of Wintry Precipitation Saturday Night – After Midnight





Round #2 of Wintry Precipitation Sunday Morning




