

S Indiana 0.25+”
N Kentucky 0.25-0.5”

Snow:
S Indiana 4 - 6+”
N Kentucky 1 - 3”

Ice:
S Kentucky 0.30-0.5”


Snow:
S Kentucky Up to 2”


