

# Snow and Arctic Blast on the Way



- A potent winter storm will drop a swath of heavy snow from the central Mississippi Valley to the eastern Great Lakes Sunday and Monday
- While the heaviest snow will remain to our north, significant snows will occur along the Ohio River

# Winter Storm Watch Sunday



- Although as is nearly always the case in the OH Valley, uncertainty still exists in the forecast track of this weather system, the currently preferred track would yield at least light snow accumulations for much of the area by Sunday night.



- Following the snowfall, arctic air will surge into region. Sub-zero temperatures will occur north of the Ohio by Monday morning, and as far as the TN border by Tuesday morning.


