

Part 1: Meteorological Analysis of 18 June 2010 Derecho

Severe thunderstorms developed over Iowa during the morning hours of 18 June 2010, quickly organizing into a fast moving bow echo as they swept east across the lower Great Lakes during the afternoon and early evening. This was a fairly classic, well anticipated progressive derecho, with meteorological conditions suggesting the potential for a significant severe weather event hours before the event began
