


## August 11, 2007: Evening Winds and Hail Across the Twin Cities

As a cold front moved into Minnesota from the west on the Saturday evening of August 11th, 2007, severe thunderstorms developed and rolled through the Twin Cities into southeast Minnesota and far southwest Wisconsin. There were widespread large hail and damaging wind reports. The largest hail size was golf ball and observed in Welch in Goodhue County. The highest wind gust measured in the local area was 64 mph in Albert Lea, though speeds up to 74 mph were recorded further east in Rochester.
