



Snowfall - November 10, 2006

As much as a foot of snow fell early on November 10th, 2006 across portions of south central and southeast Minnesota and west central Wisconsin, as a powerful low pressure system moved from the southwestern United States through Missouri and into the Ohio Valley.


Total Snowfall accumulations



The heaviest snow fell as a result of an intense band of snow, containing snowfall rates of 2 to 3 inches per hour at times, that developed from the southern portions of Faribault County northeastward through Goodhue County and finally, eastern Eau Claire County.



The band lasted for several hours, and at times, contained areas of thundersnow.



Several surface observation locations reported heavy snow and/or thundersnow for a lengthy duration, which allowed the snow to accumulate fairly rapidly. The following table shows the duration of the heavy snow and thundersnow at these locations, according to the automated surface observations received from each station.
