WHEREAS, the vast majority of flooding fatalities can be avoided with the proper preventive actions; and

WHEREAS, the keys to understanding the dangers of flooding are education and awareness; and

WHEREAS, the National Weather Service has proclaimed Wyoming Flood Awareness Week from May 7 through May 11, 2012.

NOW THEREFORE, I, MATTHEW H. MEAD, Governor of the State of Wyoming, do hereby proclaim May 7 – 11, 2012 as

FLOOD AWARENESS WEEK

in Wyoming.
