

Subject: **Severe Weather Likely Later Today**

Weather Hazards: **Severe thunderstorms with large hail and damaging winds**

Current Watches/Advisories/Warnings: **Severe weather watches possible later today.**

Overview: **A strong cold front will bring a squall line and a few supercells into the area late this afternoon and tonight.**




**Risk:** Severe thunderstorms with large hail to the size of golf balls and damaging winds in excess of 70 mph.

**Timing:** Thunderstorms will impact areas west of highway 71 by 6 PM and all of the Missouri Ozarks between 6 PM and midnight.

**Impact:** Very damaging winds in excess of 70 mph could cause significant damage.

**Outlook:** Severe weather will again be possible Tuesday.
