

Weather Hazards: **TEST TEST Severe Thunderstorms With Damaging Winds and Large Hail Sunday TEST TEST**

Risk: test Elevated Risk For Hail. Significant Risk for Damaging Thunderstorm Winds. TEST.

Timing: TEST Active weather is expected to enter the western sections of the outlook area (southeast Kansas/western Missouri) by 3 pm , then spread east into the rest of the Missouri Ozarks from 3pm through 10 pm. TEST

Impact: TEST Damaging winds of over 70 mph and up to baseball sized hail. TEST

Overview: TEST A strong cold front will move through the region on Sunday. Severe storms are expected to develop as a weak cap breaks. TEST Strong instability and moderate vertical wind shear will allow organized severe storms to develop with damaging winds and large hail possible. TEST


Prepare Now: TEST TEST Spotter Activation is expected after 3 pm Sunday. Periodically monitor regional and local radars for thunderstorm development.

Monitor the Storm Prediction Center (www.spc.noaa.gov) for the latest thunderstorms outlooks and watches.

HAM Radio: HAM Net Activation xxx.xx mhz.


