





Notice of Known Storm Damage – East of Stockton, Missouri



Important Information

- **Before you fly, contact the National Weather Service in Springfield, MO at 417-863-8028 to coordinate your flight with flights from other volunteers.**
- Date of Damage:
 - April 13th, 2014
- Area of Interest:
 - A narrow path of intermittent damage (minor tree damage and damage to outbuildings) was reported by the Cedar County Emergency Manager between Stockton and Dunnegan, MO.
- Description of Damage:
 - Trees may appear to be broken from the top or to be toppled. Roof damage to outbuildings may be visible from the air.
- Desired Survey Information:
 - Photographs of damage from the air are highly desired to determine if the winds were convergent (tornado) or divergent (downburst). If photos are not possible, locations and detailed descriptions of the damage and how it is oriented will also be useful.

Volunteer Program Information and Reminders

- This is a volunteer program intended for pilots that have already planned flying time over the areas described. You will not be compensated for your time or for fuel used. This is a 100% volunteer effort on your part.
- Always obtain a weather briefing from FAA flight services before departure by calling 1-800-WX-BRIEF.
- In addition to an FAA weather briefing, weather products from the National Weather Service Aviation Weather Center can be reviewed at <http://aviationweather.gov/stdbrief/>.
- Ensure that your route does not include any Temporary Flight Restrictions (TFR).
- After your flight, make sure to contact the National Weather Service in Springfield to let us know what you found using one of the following methods.
