...ANOTHER NIGHT OF RECORD COLD TEMPERATURES POSSIBLE WEDNESDAY NIGHT...

ANOTHER SURGE OF MODIFIED ARCTIC AIR WILL BE MOVING INTO THE REGION TONIGHT AND WEDNESDAY. THEN DURING WEDNESDAY NIGHT AND EARLY THURSDAY MORNING WINDS WILL BECOME LIGHT UNDER CLEAR SKIES WHICH WILL LEAD TO GOOD RADIATIONAL COOLING. THIS WILL ALLOW TEMPERATURES TO DROP SOME 15 TO 25 DEGREES BELOW NORMAL BY THURSDAY MORNING WITH READINGS FORECAST TO FALL BELOW FREEZING ACROSS MUCH OF THE NATURE COAST...AND INTO THE MIDDLE AND UPPER 30S IN MOST OTHER INTERIOR LOCATIONS. FROST WILL ALSO BE LIKELY ACROSS THE NATURE COAST WITH THE POTENTIAL FOR FROST FURTHER SOUTHWARD INTO INLAND PORTIONS OF CENTRAL AND SOUTHWEST FLORIDA.

THESE COLD TEMPERATURES WILL APPROACH RECORD VALUES FOR THIS DATE IN A FEW LOCATIONS...BUT NO WHERE NEAR THE ALL-TIME NOVEMBER RECORDS WHICH RANGE FROM THE HIGH TEENS ACROSS THE FAR NORTH TO UPPER 20S FAR SOUTH. BELOW IS A TABLE OF THE RECORD LOW TEMPERATURES AT SITES AROUND THE AREA FOR NOVEMBER 27.
