



# Cooler, but Still Comfortable Weather expected for the Upcoming Week

A rather progressive upper level pattern will continue during the upcoming week with a series of disturbances moving across the United States. The first of these will move out into the western Atlantic Ocean during Monday allowing some cooler drier air to move into the region.




*Upper level pattern expected Monday with red arrows indicating approximate position of the Jet Stream.*

During midweek the next disturbance will be dropping into the central United States with some weak ridging building over Florida allowing for a brief warm up.




*Upper level pattern expected Wednesday with red arrows indicating approximate position of the Jet Stream.*

By the end of the week a rather deep trough will setup over the eastern United States bringing more cool dry air into the region, with the possibility of freezing temperatures across portions of the Nature Coast.
