Key Points




- **Expected Weather:** Periods of wintry precipitation Fri night will turn to snow later Saturday afternoon. Could be a lull mid morning to early afternoon!
- **Time:**
 - Mixture starts later tonight -Snow starts after 3pm Sat
 - Peak intensity time for snow 3pm to 11pm Sat
 - Ending around midnight






Accumulating Snow and Ice



Updated: 1/2/2015 11:45 AM



- Some accumulating snow & light icing is possible across the area
- Roads will be slick, traveling may be hazardous! Stay tuned to forecast updates!
- Uncertainty:
 - Location of highest snow/ice accumulations may shift
 - Exact timing for the transition from wintry mix to all snow
 - Sat. temps may rise above freezing, supporting rain instead of ice

Impacts



- **Travel on area roads could become hazardous especially later Saturday evening through Saturday night.**
- **Northwest winds will increase Sat night and temperatures will plummet so any melting could re-freeze into early Sunday on area roads.**
