

This plot shows the probability or chance that the maximum stage or level at a point on a river will exceed a particular value in a 90 day period. The vertical axis shows river stage or level measured in feet (ft) and the horizontal axis shows time. Each vertical bar represents the probabilities for a 7 day period. Color is used to indicate probability levels or chances on the graphic.

Links to past and forecast precipitation, river level impact and historical flood information are also included on this page.

The following terminology is used when describing floods

Minor flooding - minimal or no property damage, but possibly some public threat or inconvenience.

Moderate Flooding - some inundation of structures and roads near stream. Some evacuations of people and/or transfer of property to higher elevations is necessary.

Major Flooding - extensive inundation of structures and roads. Significant evacuations of people and/or transfer of property to higher elevations.
