THE COOPERATIVE WEATHER OBSERVER IN BOULDER COLORADO REPORTED THAT
YESTERDAYS RAINFALL WAS 1.94 INCHES. THIS BROUGHT THE MONTHLY
ACCUMULATION FOR SEPTEMBER UP TO 16.69 INCHES...AND THE YEAR-TO-DATE
ACCUMULATION UP TO 29.65 INCHES. THE MONTHLY ACCUMULATION FAR
EXCEEDS THE PREVIOUS SEPTEMBER RECORD OF 5.50 INCHES...RECORDED IN
1940. IT ALSO EXCEEDS THE ALL-TIME MONTHLY ACCUMULATION OF 9.59
INCHES...IN MAY 1995.

THE YEAR-TO-DATE ACCUMULATION...29.65 INCHES...NOW ALSO ESTABLISHES
A NEW RECORD ANNUAL PRECIPITATION ACCUMULATION AT BOULDER. THE
PREVIOUS RECORD FOR ANNUAL PRECIPITATION AT THE BOULDER COOPERATIVE
STATION WAS 29.43 INCHES...SET IN 1995.
