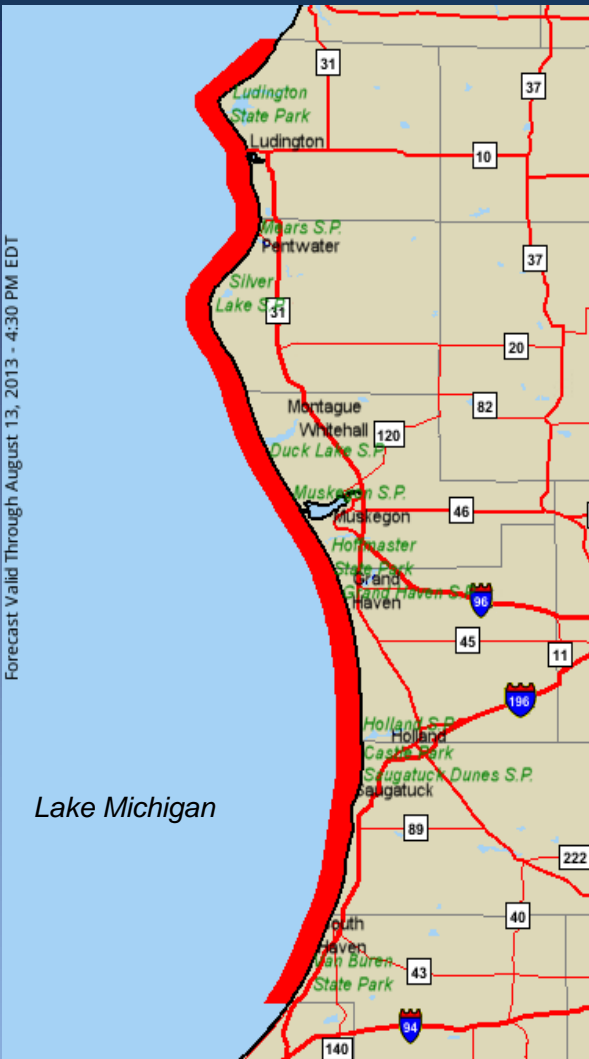


# High Waves / Dangerous Currents Through Today

Forecast Valid Through August 13, 2013 - 4:30 PM EDT

- High wave action and dangerous swimming conditions
- Waves 4-7' for Mason, Oceana and Van Buren Co. Beaches  
Waves 3-6' elsewhere
- Strong structural and long shore currents expected; rip currents also possible

## Swim Hazard Risk Level

### Low Risk

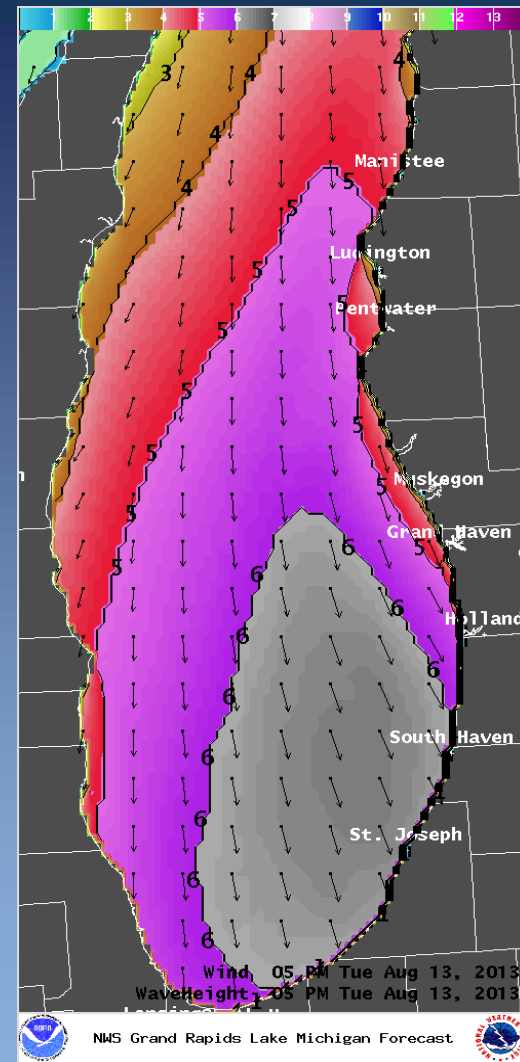
A low risk of swimming hazards imply that large waves and strong currents are not expected along the shore.

### Moderate Risk

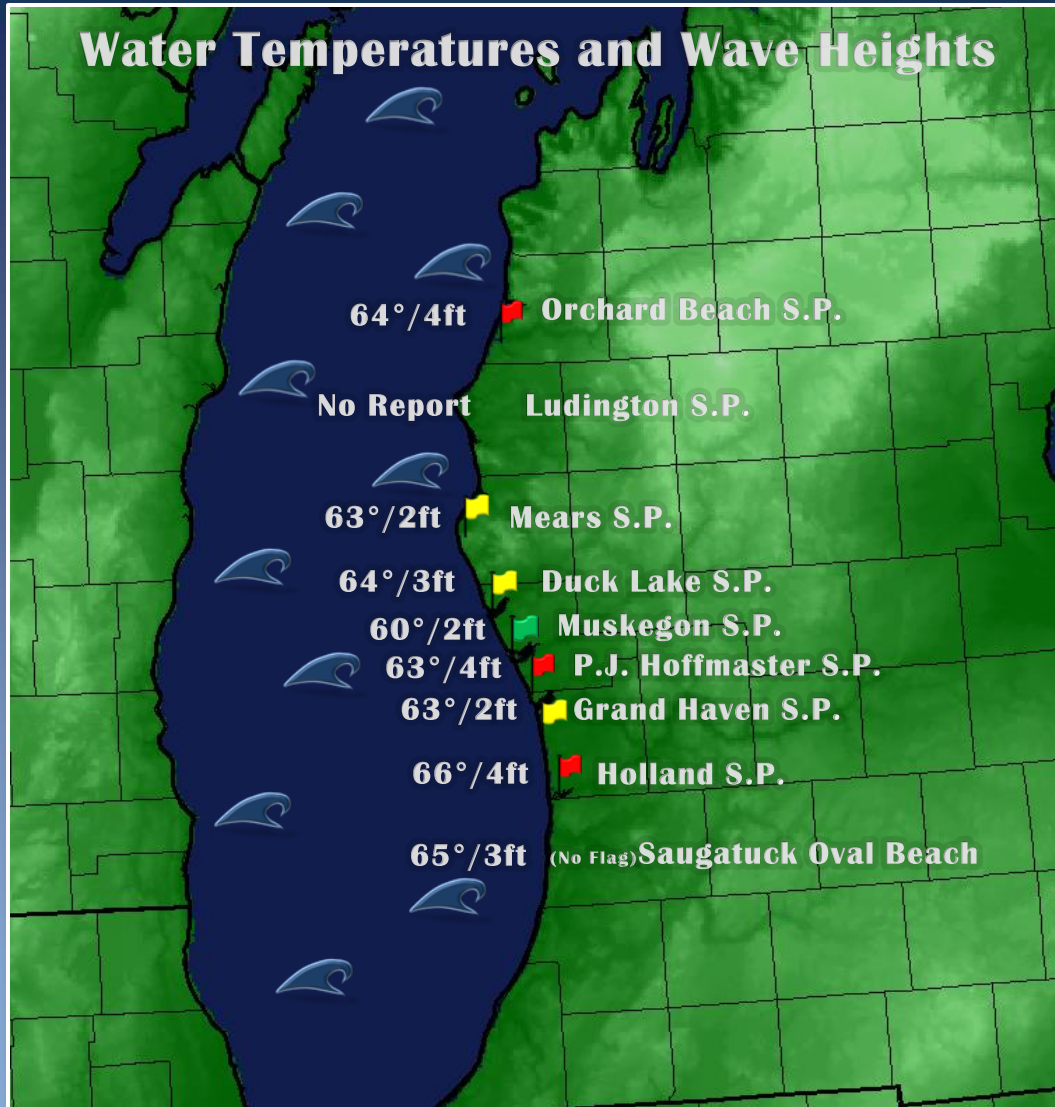
A moderate risk of swimming hazards imply that large waves and strong currents are likely along the shore. Only experienced swimmers should consider entering the water.

### High Risk

A high risk of swimming hazards imply dangerous waves and currents are expected along the shore. Swimming conditions may be life threatening to anyone entering the water.



# 10 AM Beach Conditions Report



- High wave action and dangerous swimming conditions
- Waves 4-7' at beaches along Mason, Oceana and Van Buren Co.
- 3-6 foot waves at beaches from around Mears S.P. to Saugatuck
- Strong structural and long shore currents expected; rip currents also possible
- Lasting through Tuesday Evening
