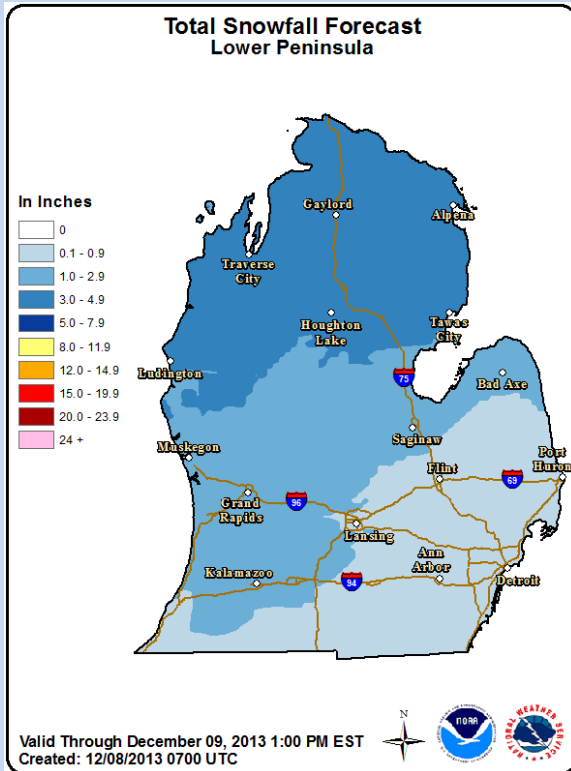

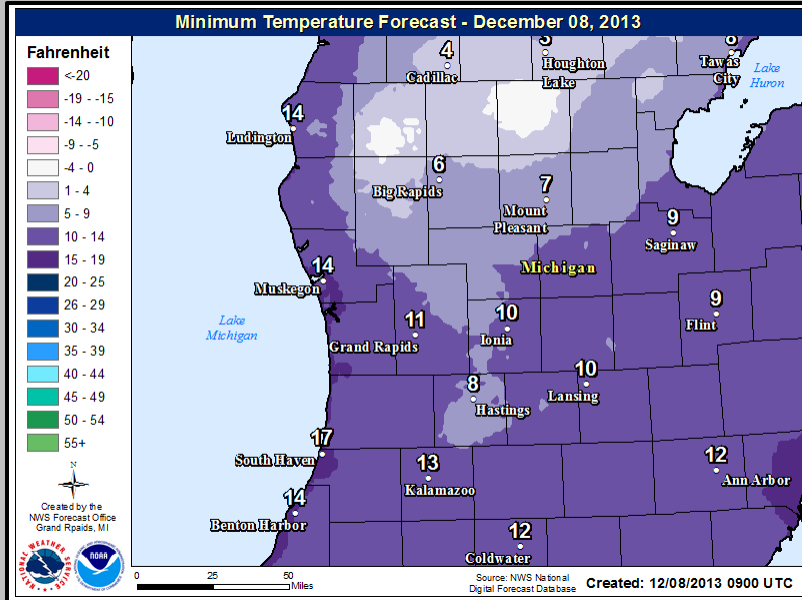

# Increasing Ice Jam Potential Through The Coming Week



High temperatures in the 20s with lows in the single digits and teens for the next several days

When water temperatures hover near freezing, snowfall can cause “flash freezes” and speed up ice jam formation on rivers
