


One to Two Inches of Snow Expected Toward Morning

Expect one to two inches of snow to accumulate near and north of Interstate 96 between about 4 AM and noon Saturday. A low pressure system tracking northeast along a nearly stationary front tonight will bring an area of precipitation across Southwest Lower Michigan from late this evening until midday Saturday. The precipitation will start out as rain late this evening then become mixed with and finally change to snow before sunrise near and north of Interstate 96. The snow will continue into the mid-morning before tapering off before noon.

Currently road temperatures are above freezing across the area. Tonight air temperatures will fall to near freezing once the precipitation changes to snow. As a result most of the snow is not expected to stick on road surfaces. Even so bridges and overpasses may become slippery by morning in areas where the snow is falling.
