






Muskegon River at Croton


Muskegon River at Evart




Grand River at Ionia





Grand River at Comstock Park










Grand River at Grand Rapids






Grand River at Robinson Township

Tonight

Lows in the lower 30s – mid 30s near the Lake Michigan coast.
Partly cloudy, dry weather
Southeast winds 10 to 15 mph

Monday

Highs 60 to 65
Mostly sunny
Southerly winds 10 to 15 mph

Tuesday

Highs 50 to 60... lower 60s in far southeast
Southerly winds 5 to 10 mph turning northwesterly
24-hour rainfall around 0.50" to 0.75"
Potential impact on Grand and Muskegon rivers will be to slow the fall
Small creeks and streams will see rises with a potential for nuisance
flooding
