Cooler Temperatures Through the Event

High Temperatures Thu through Mon: Mid to Upper 70s

Heat Index Values Thu through Mon: Less than 80 degrees

Overnight Temperatures: Upper 50s to around 60

Showers & Thunderstorms Possible: Thu-Sat

Best Chances on Thursday Afternoon/Evening and Friday

Moderate Rainfall Possible in Storms – up to 1 inch per hour

Very Low Probability of Severe Storms
Thursday Afternoon/Evening


