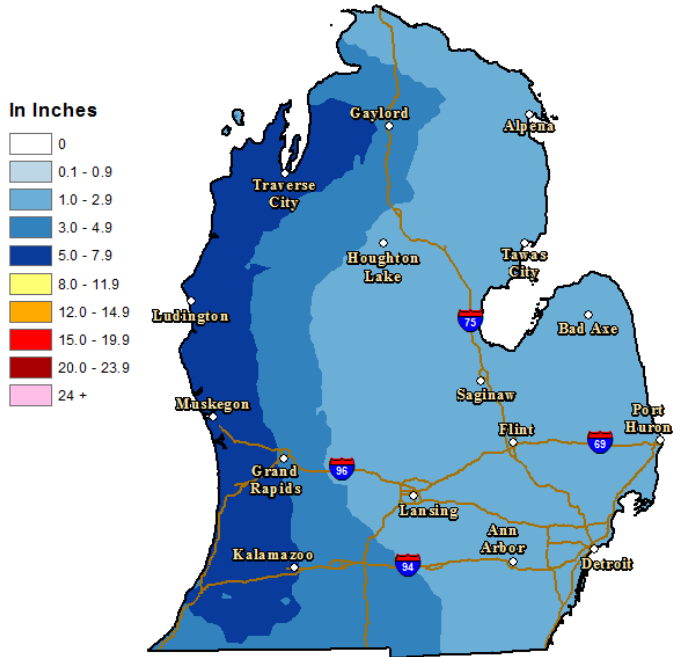




Snow, Wind and Extreme Cold Through Tuesday

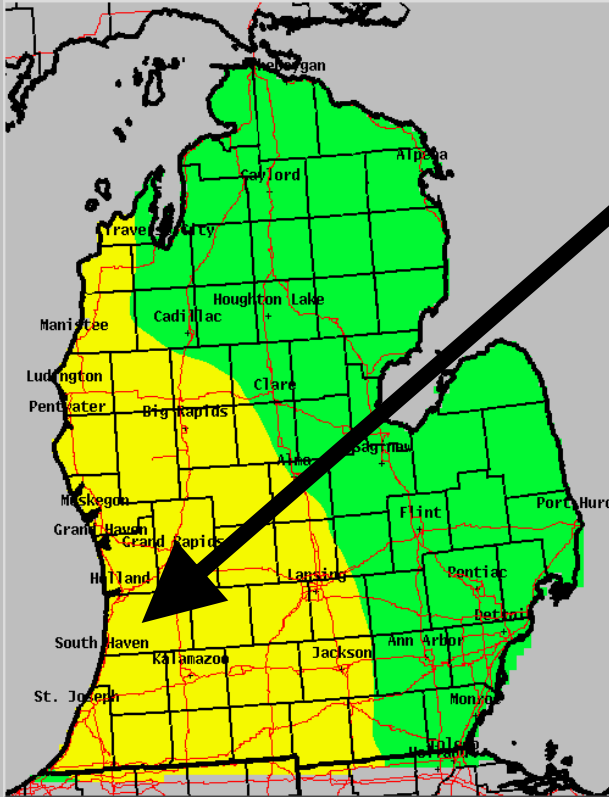

Winter Weather Expected

Sunday and Sunday Night



Including: Kalamazoo, Jackson, Lansing, Grand Rapids, Muskegon, Ludington

Expected Impacts

Hazardous Travel – Very Slow Speeds, Icy Roads, Numerous Accidents

Cleared Roads Becoming Snow Covered Tonight Especially North to South Roads

Reduced Visibilities, Whiteouts in Blowing Snow Possible Tonight

Possible Impacts

Event Cancellations

Expected Impacts

Light Snow and Some Slick Spots

Snow

2-6" Sunday and Sunday Night
Blowing and Drifting Snow-
Late Today and Tonight

Ice Accumulation

None Expected

Temperatures and Wind

Highs: Teens
Lows: Single Digits Above Zero

Winds Today: South 10 to 15 mph
Tonight: West 15 to 30 mph

Immediate – Life Saving Action

Extremely Life Threatening
Everything Will be Shut Down Possibly for Days or Weeks

Be Prepared – Major Actions

Expect Dangerous Conditions
Expect Major Disruption of Normal Activities

Be Aware – Minor Actions

Caution – Especially When Travelling
Plan to Be Inconvenienced

Little to No Action

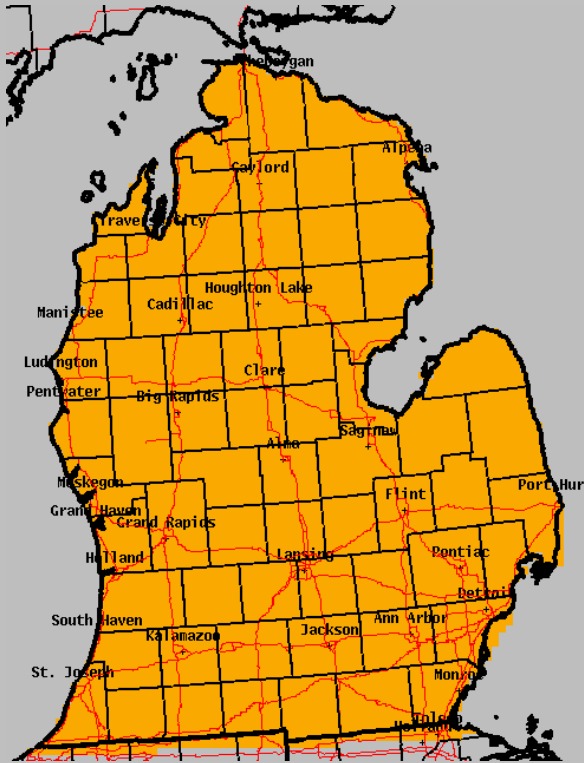

Dangerous Cold Expected Monday and Tuesday



**This Type of Cold is Rare
For Lower Michigan**

**Dangerously Cold Wind Chills
25 Below or Colder – Statewide
Frostbite Times Under 30 Minutes**

**Coldest Air Expected Monday Night
and Tuesday Morning**

Immediate – Life Saving Action	Extremely Life Threatening Everything Will be Shut Down Possibly for Days or Weeks
Be Prepared – Major Actions	Expect Dangerous Conditions Expect Major Disruption of Normal Activities

Little to No Action	Little to No Impact on Daily Life Plan on Minor Inconvenience

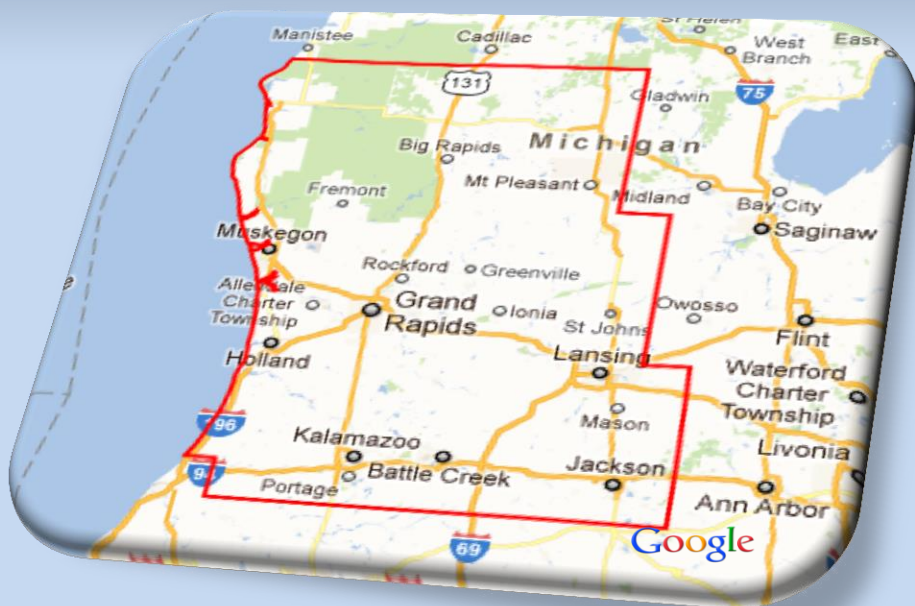
