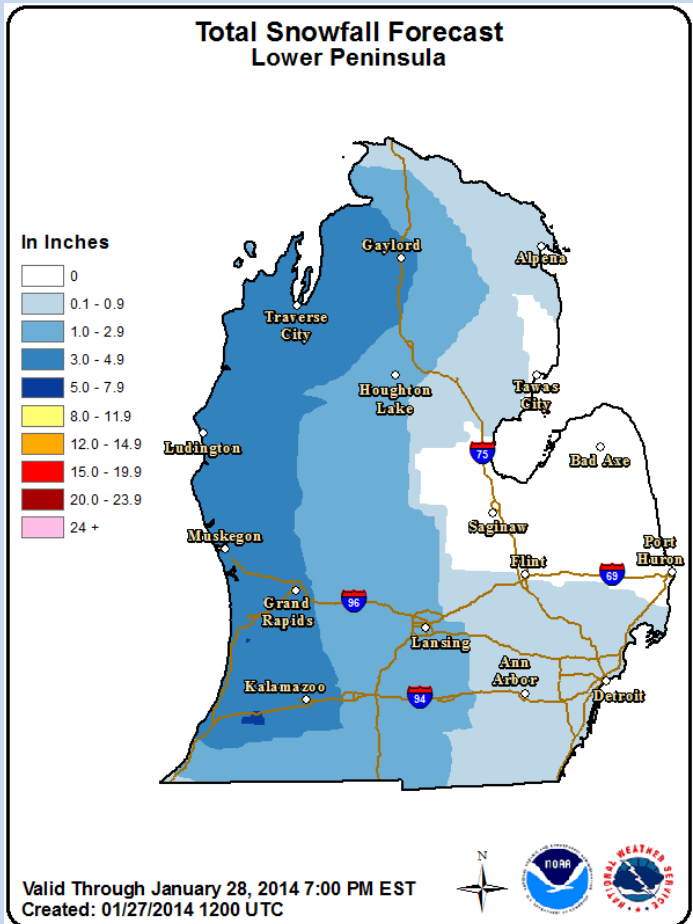




Winter Weather to Impact Michigan

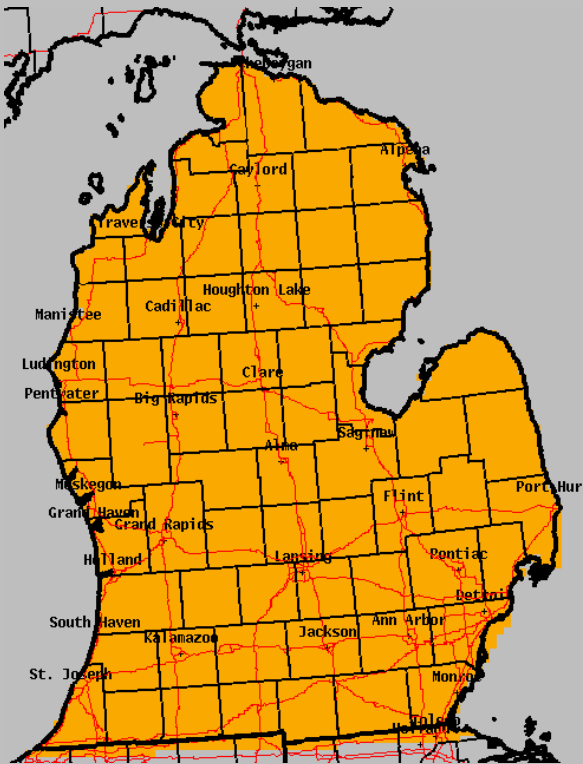

Dangerous Cold Expected Through Early Wednesday Morning



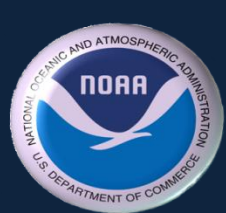
This Type of Cold is **Rare**
For Lower Michigan

Dangerously Cold Wind Chills
20 to 30 Below Zero
Frostbite Times 15-30 Minutes

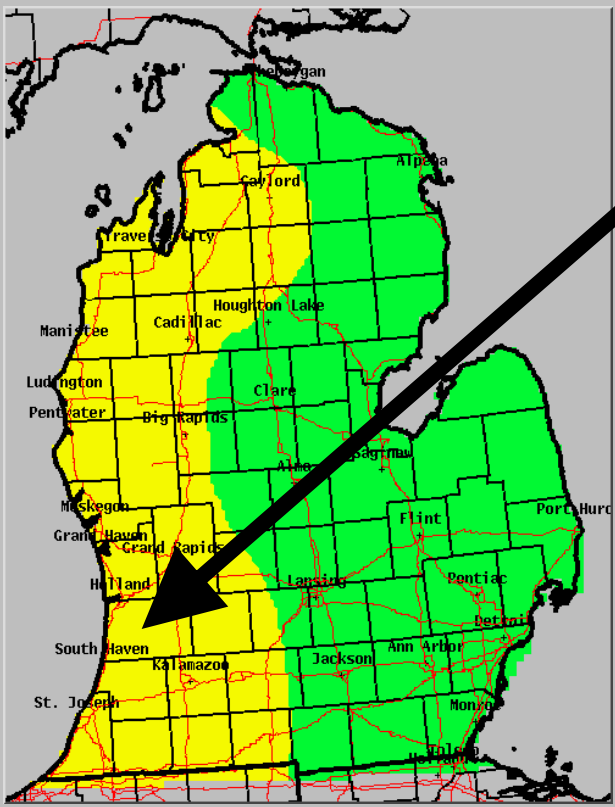
Coldest Air Expected Now
Through Tuesday Evening

Including: Muskegon, Grand Rapids, Kalamazoo, Ludington, Cadillac, Traverse City

Expected Impacts

Hazardous Travel – Very Slow Speeds, Icy Roads, Numerous Accidents

Reduced Visibilities, Whiteouts in Snow and Blowing Snow

Event Cancellations

Expected Impacts

Slick Spots and Areas of Reduced Visibilities

Snow

2-6" New Snow
Drifting/Blowing Snow

Ice Accumulation

None Expected

Temperatures and Wind

Highs: 5 to 10 Above Early, Then Falling
Lows: Zero to 10 Below Zero
Winds Tonight: West 10 to 20 mph; Gusts 25
Tuesday: Southwest 10 to 20 mph; Gusts 30

Immediate – Life Saving Action

Extremely Life Threatening
Everything Will be Shut Down Possibly for Days or Weeks

Be Prepared – Major Actions

Expect Dangerous Conditions
Expect Major Disruption of Normal Activities

Be Aware – Minor Actions

Caution – Especially When Travelling
Plan to Be Inconvenienced

Little to No Action

Little to No Impact on Daily Life
Plan on Minor Inconvenience

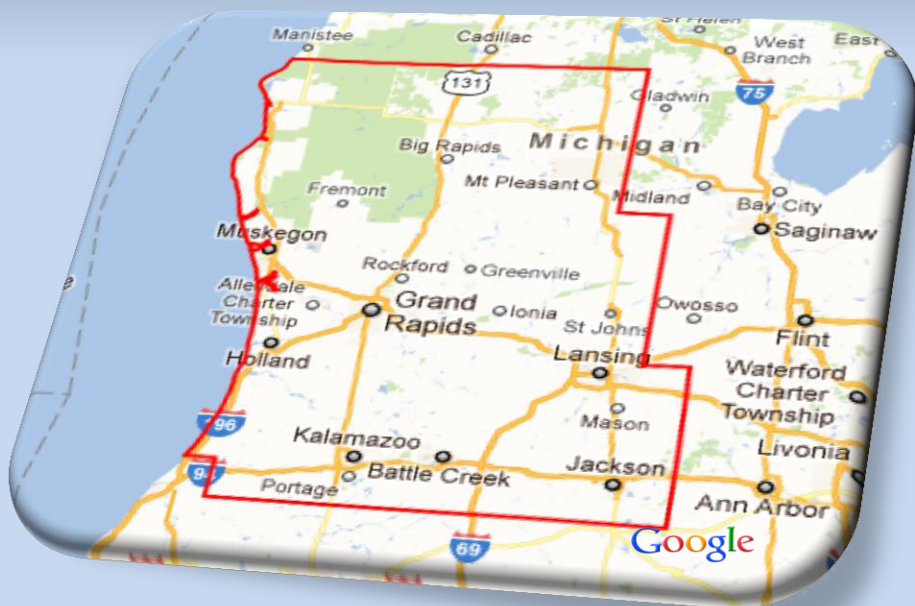
