



## Tonight through Saturday



**Including: Grand Rapids, Lansing, South Haven, Flint, Saginaw**

### Expected Impacts

Travel Significantly hampered Saturday

Difficult Snow removal and treatment

Event Cancellations, Flight Delays

Increased risk of roof collapse for flat roof buildings

Hazardous Travel

Event Cancellations/Closures

Flight Delays

### Snow

Wet and Heavy Snow

Over 6 Inches Expected

Over an Inch Per Hour Saturday

### Ice Accumulation

A Glaze of Ice Possible

Southeast Lower Michigan

### Temperatures and Wind

Lows: Teens to Lower 20s

Highs: Upper 20s to Mid 30s

Winds From the Northeast 10 mph

**Immediate – Life Saving Action**

**Extremely Life Threatening**  
Everything Will be Shut Down Possibly for Days or Weeks

**Be Prepared – Major Actions**

**Expect Dangerous Conditions**  
Expect Major Disruption of Normal Activities

**Be Aware – Minor Actions**

**Caution – Especially When Travelling**  
Plan to Be Inconvenienced

**Little to No Action**

**Little to No Impact on Daily Life**  
Plan on Minor Inconvenience






**Weather Radar Forecast



