

System One, Saturday Night



Light Snow, mainly across Southern Indiana and North Central Kentucky



Potential for a light dusting of snow, measuring a trace to around half an inch by daybreak Sunday. May continue lightly into Sunday morning.

There's a chance for a rain/snow mix down here late Saturday night becoming just light snow. May just get a trace of snow down here.






System Two, Sunday Night-Monday



Better chance for significant accumulations, possible impact with Monday morning rush hour



Potential for impactful winter weather in this area Sunday night through Monday. 1-3" accumulations are forecast. Stay tuned over the weekend for updates/advisories.

Rain will change over to light snow early Monday morning. Accumulations are forecast at an inch or less, but stay tuned for updates over the weekend.

- Two separate systems will bring a chance for winter weather
- The Saturday night system will not be as impactful
- The Sunday night/Monday system may bring 1-3" of snow to the region
 - *Possibly affecting the Monday morning rush hour*
